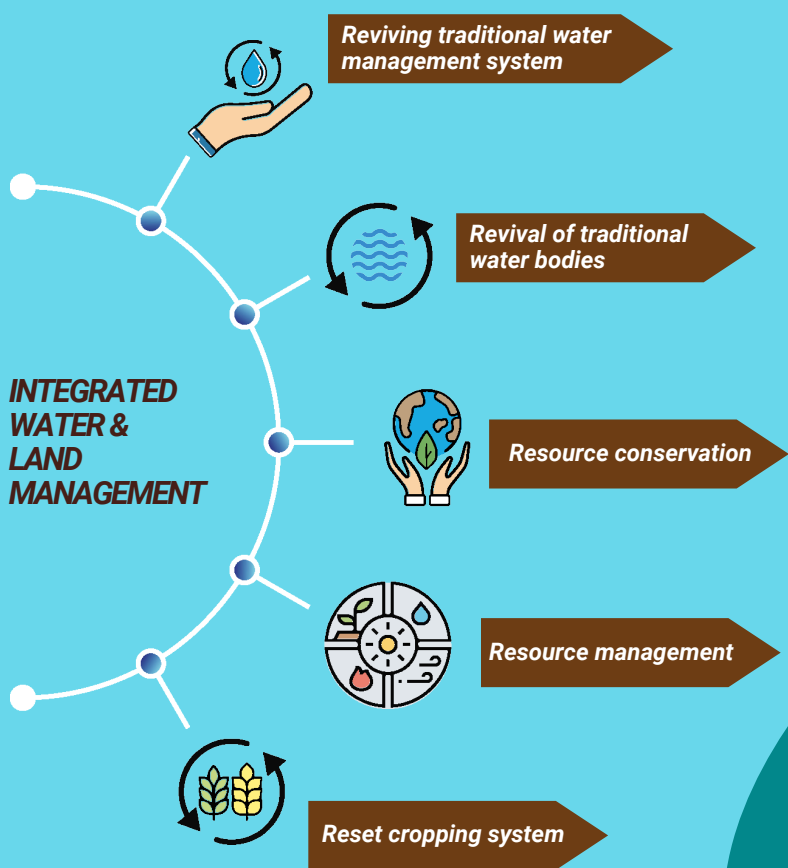


BIWAL OVERVIEW

Bundelkhand Initiative for Water, Agriculture and Livelihood (BIWAL)

is an informal joint endeavour of Civil Society Organizations concerned and involved with the socio-economic development of rural areas of Bundelkhand. This initiative is with an expectation that it will help address issues relating to climate change and achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) targets. By contextualizing it with the repair and rejuvenation of traditional water bodies, historic assets for harvesting monsoon rains, it could result in successfully integrating backwards with the natural environment and through forward integration with agriculture and livelihoods.

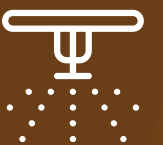
